Double-Up Blackjack takes traditional Blackjack to a whole new next level!



Double-Up Blackjack is a new game inspired by Blackjack, which allows players to double their initial wager after having seen their first two-cards (except if it's a Blackjack).

Double-Up The Win!

To participate, standard Blackjack house rules are followed until the first two cards are dealt. Then, a player may choose to stand, receive another card or **Double-Up**, by placing a second wager equal to or less than the original wager. If the player chooses to Double-Up, he/she must then stand and take no more cards.

If the player's hand beats the Dealer's, both the Double-Up wager and the main wager wins. If the Dealer beats the player's hand, both the Double-Up wager and the main wager lose. In the event that both the Dealer and player push, the Double-Up wager will lose.

'End 16' Rule

If the Dealers' hand totals 16 at any time (hard or soft), then the game will stop. All bets on the table will push, with the exception of any player with a card total of 21. A card total of 21 pays even money (1-to-1) and a natural Blackjack pays 3-to-2.

How To Play Double-Up Blackjack

1. Following standard Blackjack rules, two cards are dealt face-up to each player and one card is dealt face-up to the Dealer.
2. Each player is now presented with the option to either:
 - Stand (do nothing)
 - Receive another card, or,
 - Double-Up the original wager on any two card hand except Blackjack



3. House wins tie on Double-Up only.
4. If the dealer has 16 (hard/soft) the game is over. All 21's are paid automatically at 1-to-1 and all other wagers push.
5. If the Dealer achieves a Blackjack, only the initial bet will lose. All doubles and splits will be returned to the player.
6. Winning Double-Up wagers pay even money (1-to-1). See payable on reverse.
