# RAISE **Plus** 'EM POKER

Raise 'Em Poker Plus is an easy new side bet played with the base game Raise 'Em Poker.

## Raise 'Em Poker - The Base Game

Basic Raise 'Em Poker is a simple spin off of traditional Poker. Instead of betting against the house and other players, however, players bet on the strength of their own three-card hand in combination with the two community cards held by the Dealer. A player wins according to the payable (see over) if their five-card hand results in a pair of tens or better.

## Raise 'Em Poker **Plus** - The Side Bet

Raise 'Em Poker Plus is a natural side bet that does not change the dynamics of the game. To play, all players have to do is place an additional wager on the flashing bet sensor located above the Ante. To win, a player must hold one of five Poker hands - that's it! Players are paid according to the Raise 'Em Poker Plus payable (see over).

## Increased Chances of Winning

The top three jackpots in Raise 'Em Poker Plus increment every time a bet is placed and 'reset' once won. If one jackpot is won, however, the other jackpots remain in play (don't reset) until they're also won. This means players have an increased chance of winning since lower hands such as a Four Of A Kind or Full House can end up being worth the most!





## How To Play Raise 'Em Poker

1. Three cards are dealt facedown to each player who Antes. Another two 'community cards' are dealt facedown in front of the Dealer.
2. The players may look at their own cards and, if desired, add another bet equal to the Ante on the area marked "1".
3. Once all further bets are made, the Dealer will reveal the first community card. Players may place another bet equal to the Ante on the area marked "2". Both raises are optional and the player remains in the game even if they don't raise.
4. Once the second round of betting ends, the Dealer will reveal the second community card, checking each player's hand for a win. If the combination of the player's cards and the community cards create a Pair Of Tens or better, the player is paid as per the payable (see over).

## How To Play Raise 'Em Poker **Plus**

1. After placing an initial Raise 'Em Poker Ante, the player must also place a wager on the flashing bet sensor.
2. Regular Raise 'Em Poker gameplay will commence and if the player holds a Straight Flush, Four Of A Kind, Full House, Flush or Straight, they win according to the payable (see over). The side bet loses if any other combination is dealt.
