

HOW TO PLAY

Introducing 3 Card Draw Poker, the fun and fast paced new Poker game.



Three Card Draw Poker is played with a single standard 52-card deck.

Players must make a mandatory ANTE wager before the game can begin. Players may also make an optional progressive bet wager.

After all bets have been placed, each player is dealt three cards face down. Once all players have received their cards, the dealer is dealt 4 cards face down.

Each player in turn, has one of three options to play their hand:

- Fold and lose ANTE and progressive bet (if played).
- Play by placing an IN TO WIN bet equal to the ANTE (no card drawn).
- Play by placing a DRAW bet equal to the ANTE bet and receive a draw card (Player will discard one card and receive one new card from the dealer).

After all player decisions, have been made the dealer will reveal their 4 cards and make the best possible 3 card poker hand.

The Dealers hand always qualifies.



Payout Combinations

3 Card Poker Hand Rankings

Rankings are represented from lowest to highest:

High Card, Pair, Flush, Straight, Three of a Kind, Straight Flush, and Mini-Royal (defined as a suited Q, K, A).

The dealer will compare the house hand with the player's hands and resolve the wagers as per standard 3 card poker rankings.

ANTE and IN TO WIN/DRAW - ODDS

Bets will be paid at 1 to 1 for ANTE and IN TO WIN/DRAW wagers if the players hand beats the dealers hand.

The player's ANTE and IN TO WIN/DRAW wagers will lose if the dealer's hand beats the player's hand.

The player's ANTE and IN TO WIN /DRAW wagers will push if both the dealer's and player's hands tie.

IN TO WIN/DRAW Bonus

Irrespective of whether the player wins, loses or ties the dealer's hand; they will be paid a BONUS on their IN TO WIN/DRAW wager when a player's final hand is a straight or better.

Straight	1 To 1
Three of a Kind	5 To 1
Straight Flush	10 To 1
Mini Royal	20 To 1

PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT

To participate in the 3 Card Draw Poker Progressive, the bet must be made prior to the dealing of the cards.

Bets will be placed on the bet sensor and will be illuminated by a light indicating acceptance of the bet. Any progressive bet sensors that are not illuminated will not be valid for entry to the progressive jackpot.

Prior to the commencement of dealing the cards, the dealer will activate the lock-out button, indicating that no more bets will be accepted for the progressive jackpot.

WINNING PROGRESSIVE COMBINATIONS

All winning progressive jackpot payouts will be made at the end of each game.

Combinations of the jackpot payouts apply to either a 'natural' 3 card hand dealt or if a card has been drawn by the player to qualify for a progressive payout.

3 Card Draw Progressive Pay Table

Hand	Prog Pay	Odds
Mini Royal Diamond	100%	0 for 1
Mini Royal Other	50%	0 for 1
Straight Flush	10%	0 for 1
Trips	0%	10
Straight	0%	5
