

## What sets Poker Bo apart?

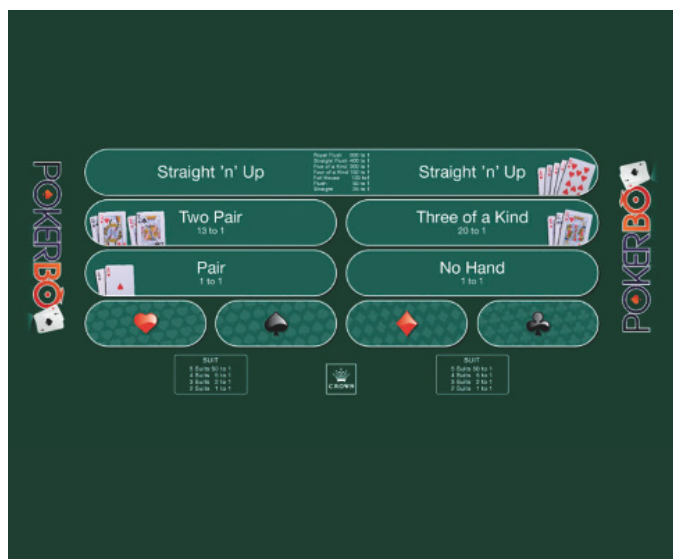


### Gameplay

Poker Bo games are quick and fun for new and experienced players of Sicbo and Poker, with players having the option of placing bets on any combination of six wagers which indicate the Poker hand the dealer will draw from five cards.

Poker Bo features no competitive element between players and games are often filled with the buzz of comradery, with players watching in suspense to see if their wagers have won anywhere from a 1:1 pay-out, to 500:1!

With easy to follow wagers and pay-outs for players and dealers alike, Poker Bo is the perfect game for any casino.



### Game Overview

Combining elements of Poker with the thrill of Sicbo, Poker Bo leaves its players in suspense with every turn of the card.

Poker Bo is the exciting new game from CLUB Gaming Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Crown Resorts Ltd and exclusively distributed globally by TCSJOHNHUXLEY.

Although Poker Bo draws on elements of both Poker and Sicbo, it is a standalone table game, not based on the results of any other propriety game.

### How to Play

To begin, players place their bets on any combination of the six wager options available; Straight 'n' Up, Three of a Kind, Two Pair, Pair, No Hand and Specific Suit.

When all betting has taken place, the dealer indicates to all players that there are no more bets.

The dealer then draws five cards from the deck and reveals each of the cards.

The dealer then checks the card values to see if any Poker hands have been made and checks against each players wagers. If any wagers placed match with a Poker hand, the player is then awarded the appropriate pay-out from the paytables below.

Be aware that some five card hands will result in more than one wager winning.



## Wager Options

Poker Bo comprises of the following six wager options, which players can play in any combination:

### Straight 'n' Up:

Straight 'n' Up wagers win in the event that the five card hand forms one of the following hands:

- Royal Flush – Five cards of consecutive rank and the same suit consisting 10, Jack, Queen, King, and Ace.
- Straight Flush – Five cards of consecutive rank and the same suit not constituting a Royal Flush.
- Five of a Kind – Five cards consisting of five cards of the same rank.
- Four of a Kind – Five cards consisting of four cards of the same rank and an additional card of different rank.
- Full House – Five cards consisting of three cards of the same rank and an additional two cards of the same rank as each other but not the other three cards.
- Flush – Five cards consisting of five cards all of the same suit not constituting a Royal Flush, Straight Flush, Five of a Kind, Four of a Kind, or Full House.
- Straight – Five cards of consecutive rank where not all cards are of the same suit.

### No Hand:

No Hand wagers win in the event that the five card hand forms one of the following hands:

- No Hand – Five cards that do not constitute a Royal Flush, Straight Flush, Five of a Kind, Four of a Kind, Full House, Flush, Straight, Three of a Kind, Two Pair, or Pair.

### Three of a Kind:

Three of a Kind wagers win in the event that the five card hand forms one of the following hands:

- Three of a Kind - Five cards consisting of three cards of the same rank and an additional two cards not of the same rank as each other or the other three cards.

### Two Pair:

Two Pair wagers win in the event that the five card hand forms one of the following hands:

- Two Pair - Five cards consisting of two cards of the same rank, a further two cards of the same rank as each other but not the first two cards and an additional card not of the same rank as the other four cards.

### Pair:

Pair wagers win in the event that the five card hand forms one of the following hands:

- Pair - Five cards consisting of two cards of the same rank and an additional three cards not of the same rank as each other or the other two cards.

### Specific Suit:

Specific Suit wagers win when two or more of the five drawn cards belong to the same suit. Player pay-out values are dependant on the number of cards that belong to the specific suit that occur in the five card hand, which is explained in the pay-tables.

- There are four Specific Suit wagers corresponding to the four suits (Spades, Hearts, Diamonds, and Clubs).

**Note:** Some five card hands will result in more than one wager winning. In these circumstances, only the highest Poker hand will qualify for a pay-out.

## Pay-outs and House Edge

The calculations provided below are determined by systematically counting all possible combinations of cards in the game of Poker Bo as described above. Described is the 6 deck variation of the game.

### Straight 'n' Up Wager – 6 Deck
