Rockets to Riches is an exciting and easy new side bet, which makes the traditional game of Blackjack soar to new heights!

How to Play

Rockets to Riches is extremely easy to play. All that's required, is for the player to place a side bet on the flashing sensor located in front of the bet box, in addition to a regular Blackjack wager.

Once all wagers have been placed, the players and dealer are dealt cards according to the standard Blackjack rules.

The outcome of the Rockets to Riches side-bet is resolved based on the player's first two cards, plus the additional cards immediately dealt in the case of split Aces. It's as simple and straightforward as that!

The Rockets to Riches pay tables are set for the following Blackjack configurations:

- Shoe of 6 or 8 decks
- European Blackjack rules (dealer does not peek for Blackjack).

Progressive Awards

The pay table for Rockets to Riches includes progressive awards as well as fixed odds. Only the first listed award is paid to the player. The following outcomes qualify for awards:

- The player splits Aces and is dealt Kings of suits matching each respective Ace to both hands.
- The player splits Aces and is dealt Kings of any suit to both hands.
- The player splits Aces and is dealt 10-valued cards (for a total of 21) to both hands.
- The player splits Aces and is dealt a 10-valued card to one hand.
- The player splits Aces and is not dealt any 10-valued cards.
- The player is initially dealt an Ace but the second card is not an Ace.

Note: If the player is dealt two Aces and chooses not to split, it will be considered for the purposes of Rockets to Riches as if the player had split Aces and not received any 10-valued cards.



Rockets to Riches Progressive Paytable

Hand	Paytable
Split Aces <i>(A/K Suited + A/K Suited)</i>	Top Progressive Jackpot
Split Aces <i>(Ace/King + Ace/King)</i>	Second Progressive Jackpot
Split Aces <i>(21 + 21)</i>	Third Progressive Jackpot
Split Aces <i>(one hand totalling 21)</i>	50:1
Pair of Aces	25:1
First Card Ace	3:1
